I have read the <u>Central Ealing Neighbourhood Development Plan 2017-2026</u> which has been prepared by the Central Ealing Neighbourhood Forum.

I fully endorse the content of this Neighbourhood Development Plan and support its policies, objectives and recommended actions. The Neighbourhood Development Plan's policies and objectives are consistent with the way in which I consider that Ealing Town Centre should be developed over the next ten years.

I hope that the independent examiner will approve the Neighbourhood Development Plan and recommend its adoption.

I also hope that the boundary of the area within which the referendum will take place will be drawn as widely as possible, as there are many residents in the Borough of Ealing who live outside the Neighbourhood Development Plan area, but depend to a large extent on the facilities available to them in Central Ealing.

As regards the area to the north-east of the town centre and north of the mainline railway, including where I live, I hope that the referendum area would extend northwards as far as Western Avenue and eastwards as far as Hanger Lane. At the very minimum, the referendum area should include Madeley Road, Ealing Village, Woodville Gardens, Woodville Road, Mount Park Road, Montpelier Road, Corfton Road, Hillcrest Road and Park View Road etc, and preferably areas further afield, too.
